

Community Health Manager #2020-07 (BHHC-STROUD) The position will provide overall supervision of the Community Health Nursing and Transportation Programs. Responds to inquiries and requests for CHS and medical assistance via telephone, written communication or personal visit. Coordinates these requests and provides consultation to resolve problems or issues. Promotes coordination of services designed to promote the patients' progress through the continuum of care with the maximum use of available resources and navigation through systems. Performs initial assessments in order to develop a comprehensive plan of care that will address patient needs. Provides coordination and service delivery to emphasize medical knowledge of the injury and disease process, including the expected length of recovery and available treatment options. Knowledge of principles and methods of sound management practices including communication, establishment of priorities and participative management. Knowledge of community resources and the laws affecting persons with disabilities as well as those community resources and services that are available to address the needs of the individuals being served through the case management process. Must have Associate Degree of Nursing, Bachelor of Nursing preferred. Current unrestricted Registered Nurse License. At least (5) years of home community/home health experience.
