

Nurse Practitioner (BHHC- Stroud) 2019-51- provide comprehensive primary health care to all age groups including neonates, infants, children, adolescents, adults, and geriatric patients of the Black Hawk Health Center. Develop treatment plans based on scientific rationale, standards of care, and professional practice guidelines. Diagnose and treat acute/chronic health care problems such as illnesses, infections, and injuries. Prescribe medications based of efficacy, safety, dosage and frequencies to the extent allowable by state guidelines and clinic regulations. Knowledge of human behavior and performance, individual difference in ability, personality, and interest; learning and motivation, psychological methods; and assessment and treatment of behavioral and affective disorders. Ability to identify a medical problem determine appropriate action to meet the problem, including referrals to a physician. Must possess a Nurse Practitioner degree from an accredited school. Must be certified by the American Association of Nurse Practitioners or American Nursing. Credentialing Center. Must be fully licensed (maintained/unrestricted) as a Nurse Practitioner in the state of Oklahoma.
