Experience working within tribal governments and of tribal customs preferred. Bachelor's degree in Social Work, Counseling or related field. May accept equivalent work experience in lieu of education. A valid driver's license is required. Must be able to pass a drug test, background check, OSBI, as well as Fingerprinting as required by the Adam Walsh Act. Indian Preference is given for this position.
