**ELDERS LAWN CARE ASSISTANCE
RESPONSIBILITY LETTER**

Dear Tribal Member;

It is the mowing season and as you are being assisted with your lawn care needs it is important to remember a few very important lawn care precautions.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TRIBAL MEMBER

- 1: Lawn should be debris free. This includes all trash, cans, bottles, toys, etc. There should be nothing on the lawn where your provider will be mowing.
- 2: Remove any and all large items that may interfere with the lawn care. If large items are left in the yard (i.e. tires, hoses, etc.) your provider will have to go around that area.
- 3: Notify the lawn care provider beforehand of any pipes or other items that are imbedded in the ground if any portion of that item is exposed above the ground.

(This information helps protect the lawn care provider from harm and also allows him/her to protect his/her equipment).

A lawn is considered to be less than an acre in size & in proportion with a normal sized urban lot. It is at the discretion of the lawn care provider to determine if the lawn is larger than deemed allowable in size. If a lawn is larger than allowed, the lawn care provider will only mow the portion around the home that constitutes a normal sized yard.

If you as the tribal member request the provider to mow and or weed more, it is your responsibility to pay the provider for that portion. The SFN RAP Lawn Care Program is only responsible for payment of \$50 for the above mentioned sizes.

If our lawn care providers have any issues regarding the safety of a lawn or the size of a lawn that cannot be resolved between the homeowner & provider; service will be suspended until the RAP Department assesses the situation and reaches a mutual resolution with both parties.
