

## Pharmacy To Be Closed October 18 and 19 To Move Back To BHHC

The BHHC Pharmacy has been undergoing a remodel the last two months as many of our patients have noticed. We have relocated to the trailer behind Behavior Health and appreciate your patience with the inconvenience of having to walk over to get your medicine. The process is almost complete and we plan to move back to the clinic soon. We already have new floors and freshly painted walls. We will have more space in the pharmacy and a new conference room to better serve our patients. The remodel comes with an automated robotic system to help make us more efficient and help prevent human errors in filling your prescriptions. We will also have an electronic signature capture

machine for you to sign when picking up prescriptions.

The Pharmacy will be closed Thursday and Friday, October 18 & 19, 2012 in order to move back to the clinic and be trained on the automated robotic system. We will not be able to fill prescriptions on those two days and the providers will not be seeing patients those two days. We will reopen on Monday, October 22 in our new pharmacy in the clinic. Please plan to pick up your refills before or after those dates. Behavior Health, Merle Boyd Center, Health Information Management, and Contract Health Services will be open to help you on Thursday, Oct. 18 from 8:00 to noon and on Friday, Oct. 19 from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm.
