

NOTICE SALE OF OIL AND GAS MINING LEASES ALLOTTED SAC AND FOX NATION STROUD, OKLAHOMA 74079

SEALED BIDS will be received until September 5, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. Central Standard Time and opened at that time at the Sac and Fox Nation Community Building, 5 1/2 miles South on Highway 99, bids received are for the leasing of allotted lands located in Lincoln, Payne and Pottawatomie Counties.

This sale will be conducted under regulations promulgated by the Secretary of the Interior 25 CFR 212 (Act of March 3, 1909; 35 Stat. 781-783; 25 U.S.C. 396) as to the allotted lands. The right is reserved to reject any and all bids and to disapprove any lease submitted on an accepted bid. The specified tracts of land are being offered subject to the acceptance by the individual Indian owners of the allotted land. A separate lease will be drawn on the applicable forms for each unit of land. The right is reserved to waive any informality in bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in the interest of the Indian owners or the United States. THE SIGNATURES OF ALL COMPETENT ADULT OWNERS MUST BE OBTAINED BY THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDERS.

Each of the specific tracts is offered separately to qualified bidders. A listing of offered tracts can be obtained by contacting, Charlotte Gray, Realty Specialist, at (918) 968-3526, ext.1023.

Subject to the foregoing, leases will be awarded to the bidder who offers the highest money bonus on a per tract basis. Conditional or alternate bids will not be considered. No drilling propositions will be considered as part of the bonus offer. Each bid must be accompanied by a deposit of at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the bonus bid. ALL DEPOSITS ARE TO BE MADE BY CASHIER'S CHECK MADE PAYABLE TO THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS. A SEPARATE CHECK MUST ACCOMPANY EACH BID. Deposits received from unsuccessful bidders will be promptly returned. The successful bidder or bidders will be required to pay their proportionate share of the advertising costs. In the event that no bid is received or accepted on a requested unit, the cost of advertising may be assessed against the applicant who requested that the land be advertised. In the event two or more bids are in the same amount and such bids are the high bids, the bidders submitting the tie high bids may be required to submit re-bids on the day of the sale to determine the successful bidder.

WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER NOTIFICATION OF BEING THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER, THE BIDDER MUST REMIT THE BALANCE OF THE BONUS, THE FIRST YEAR'S RENTAL FOR ADVERTISING COSTS, TOGETHER WITH A FILING FEE OF \$75.00 FOR EACH APPROVED LEASE, AND SHALL FILE WITH THE REALTY DIRECTOR THE LEASE IN COMPLETED FORM.

The Realty Director may, for good and sufficient reasons, extend the period for completing and filing the lease, but NO EXTENSION SHALL BE GRANTED FOR REMITTING THE BALANCE OF THE MONIES DUE.

Lessee shall furnish with each lease a corporate surety bond with surety acceptable to the United States, in the amount of \$2,500.00 and before commencement of any drilling operations, lessee shall furnish an additional bond in the amount of not less than \$10,000.00 per well; or the lessee may file one Collective Bond (Form 5-5430) in the sum of \$50,000.00 with the Southern Plains Regional Office, Anadarko, Oklahoma, for all leases of minerals in the Southern Plains Region.

In lieu of the foregoing bonds, a lessee may furnish a \$150,000.00 Nationwide Oil and Gas Lease Bond (Form 5-156) for full nationwide coverage with an acceptable company authorized to act as sole surety to cover all oil and gas leases or permits to which the lessee may become a party.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: All successful bidders will be required to prepare their own leases and obtain the signatures of all Indian lessors of allotted lands. Leases will be drawn on the standard government form (AAO-81) which may be obtained from the Realty Director, Sac and Fox Nation. The successful bidder assumes the responsibility of obtaining the appropriate forms. Unless otherwise noted in the schedule, the leases will be drawn for a maximum term of three (3) years from the date of approval by the Southern Plains Regional Director, Anadarko, Oklahoma, and as long thereafter as oil and/or gas is produced in paying quantities. The rate of royalty is twenty percent (20%) on all leases. The annual rent (\$3.00 per acre) paid in advance for any one year is not considered as a credit on the royalty.

If the lessee shall commence actual drilling with a rig designed to go to the total proposed depth and such drilling shall commence by midnight on the last day of the primary term of the lease and shall continue until the well is fully completed to production or abandonment, the lessee shall have the right to drill such well to completion with reasonable diligence and this lease shall continue and be in force with like effect as if such well had been completed within the term of years herein first mentioned.

All Departmental leases awarded under this advertisement contain a section to provide that all acreage not included in a unit and not producing or upon which drilling operations have not commenced shall be released at the expiration of the primary term and further that the lease shall terminate as to all non-producing formations at the expiration of the primary term of the lease.

Also included in all Departmental leases awarded under this advertisement are two new sections to address surface damages and geological or geophysical permits.

The responsibility of complying with any requirement of the Federal Documentary Stamp statutes is that of the successful bidders.

In addition to all other remedies provided by law, failure of the successful bidder to comply with the terms of the sale shall render the twenty-five (25%) of the total bonus bid theretofore paid by him forfeited for the use and benefit of the Indian lessor(s) without further action of the part of this office.


