The Shawnee News Star In Cooperation With Tribes Publishes Magazine

Our Native Traditions 2013, newly published, features the history and information about the Sac and Fox, Cheyenne and Arapaho, Ioway, Kialegee, Seminole, Citizen Potawatomi, Choctaw, Kickapoo, and Caddo nations. The magazine is now a part of the school curriculum in Oklahoma with copies available in the tribes' offices.

Tribal member Christina Walker recognized that the schools had few resources with which to teach the students

about any tribal history. She initiated a plan for the publication, which allows schools to learn about the tribes from the tribes. Walker personally visited and kept in regular communication with each tribe during the development process.

The *Shawnee News Star*, in cooperation with the tribes, published the magazine, sponsored by TransCanada, Shawnee Care Center, Hamburger King, Jones Appraisal, Demco Printing, Don's Copiers Plus, and Love's Country Store.
