



## Sac and Fox Nation Partners with Chickasaw Nation to Present Diabetes Program

The Sac and Fox Nation has partnered with the Chickasaw Nation to present a unique diabetes awareness/prevention activity for grades one through three at Parkview Elementary in Stroud, Ok. The activity is called The Eagle Adventure and is based upon a series of four books called the Eagle Book Series.

The books were developed by Centers for Disease Control Division of Diabetes Translation's Native Diabetes Wellness Program, in collaboration with the Tribal Leaders Diabetes Committee and the Indian Health Service, in response to the burden of diabetes among Native Americans

and the need for diabetes prevention materials for children with the goal of providing a vision of hope that type 2 diabetes could be prevented through healthful food and physical activity choices. The Eagle play was developed to bring the Eagle Books to life and as an introductory to the Eagle Adventure.

The Eagle Adventure Play was presented to Grades 1-3 at Parkview Elementary on January 24, 2013. Clarissa Littlehead, Health Director for Black Hawk Health Center introduced the play. Larry Foley and Anthony Ramirez lead the audience in the "Eagle Song" at the end of the play.

## SEQUOYAH NATIONAL RESEARCH CENTER SUMMER INTERNSHIPS

The Sequoyah National Research Center (SNRC) seeks three tribally affiliated student interns for summer 2013 during the period June 1 through July 31. Interns will work at least 25 hours per week in the Center doing basic archival and research work under the direction of Center staff.

The SNRC at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock (UALR) houses the papers and special collections of tribal individuals and organizations, the world's largest archival collection of newspapers and other periodicals published by tribal individuals and organizations, and the Dr. J.W. Wiggins Collection of Native American Art, consisting of more than 2,300 artworks, a massive archive documenting this collection, and a reference library on indigenous art with more than a thousand volumes.

The goal of the American Indian Student Internship Program is to provide students an experiential learning environment in which to acquire an understanding of the value of archives and the research potential of the collections of the Center and to engage in academic research and practical database building activities related to tribal culture, society, and issues. Interns will be expected to demonstrate the value of their experience by providing a summary report of work, finding aids for collections, reports of research, or other written work that may be shared with their home institutions.

### To qualify for an internship, students must

- Be tribally affiliated

- Have completed at least 60 college hours
- Be in good standing at their home institutions of higher learning

### Applications should include

- A unofficial copy of the student's academic transcript
- A reference or sponsor letter from the head of the student's major department or from another relevant academic official
- A statement of no more than one page expressing why the intern experience would likely be beneficial to the student's academic or career goals.

To assist the student in meeting expenses during the two-month tenure of the internship, the Center will provide on-campus housing and \$2,000 to defray other living expenses.
