Sac and Fox library adds OverDrive to system

The Sac and Fox National Public Library has just joined the Ok Virtual Library, a consortium of Oklahoma libraries providing digital collections.

You can now download e-books (including narrated e-books), audiobooks and music to your own e-reader be it an iPad, Nook, Kindle or smart phone.

Patrons will also be able to borrow from all members in the consortium, not just items in the Sac and Fox Library.

There are 40 libraries in the state of Oklahoma who are members of the consortium. Patrons can borrow from all libraries that are members of the consortium.

Currently there are over 20,000 e-books and 4,500 audiobooks available.

This service is available for card-holding members of the Library. If you don't have a SFNPL card, we can set one up for you in a couple of minutes.

Hoodies have been added to the items for sale in the gallery. The hoodies come in a variety of colors, including OU red, OSU orange, black and beige. All are zipped-up hoodies, except for the beige ones, which are pullovers.

We also have books, ball caps, tote bags and mugs for sale. All profits benefit the Library.

NOTICE

During the processing of the Form 1099-MISC for the 2014 Per Capita payment an error was made on that form. The amount received by each member was incorrectly keyed into Box 7 of that form rather than Box 3.

As a result, when a taxpayer prepares their individual return incorrect amounts of withholding and incorrect type(s) of taxes (e.g., self-employment taxes, etc.) are going to be reported as needing to be remitted.

We are in the process of contacting Fundware and having the incorrect Form 1099-MISC changed. Once that change has been made a new Form 1099-MISC with the CORRECTED box check will be issued to each Nation member. Moreover, the Nation's informational return will also be amended and a corrected form will be sent to the Internal Revenue Service.
