- Applicants who fail to comply with this requirement will not be eligible for funding in the subsequent school year.
- Abuse of a grant award by making purchases of items for other purposes or for persons other than the awardee shall lose all consideration for future funding.

Applicants should note that failure to comply and/or abuse of an award for one child places future funding for all of their qualified children at risk.

All receipts and expended cards must be turned in by the end of the school year.
