

Sac and Fox Nation Revenue Allocation Plan

The Sac and Fox Nation Tribal School Clothing/School Supply Grant will provide a clothing grant in the form of a "VISA Gift Card" to eligible enrolled Sac and Fox Nation students in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for the Academic School Year 2011-2012 **until all funds are expended**. In addition, a school supply grant in the form of a Wal-Mart gift card in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) will be provided. Tribal students, Pre-K through 12th grade, who are attending school or who are being home-schooled are eligible to submit a grant application. An applicant may apply only once during the 2011-2012 school year and all funding is on a "first come - first served" basis.

The Tribal School Clothing/School Supply Grant Application must be completely filled out by the applicant before being taken to the School to obtain the signature from an authorized school official. (Authorized school official means Superintendent, Principal or School

Secretary. Please be sure and include the official title of the signatory.) An official school stamp or seal **must** show on the original signed application. The Statement of Acknowledgment on the application form must be signed by the applicant.

A separate application must be filled out for each child. If you have more than one child, please photocopy these forms.

Remember application forms must be completely and properly filled out or will be returned to sender, "NO EXCEPTIONS". **Applications are due to the Education Department no later than September 10, 2011.**

Applications containing all required documentation will be processed in a timely manner. After the application is processed a "Letter of Authorization" will be mailed along with the gift card to the parent or legal guardian of the eligible student applicant. This "Letter of Authorization" will be used in conjunction with the gift cards for the actual purchases.

School Clothing Grant Guidelines

PROGRAM FUNCTIONS:

To provide for the education, health and social welfare needs of Sac and Fox Nation school-aged children. Native American children historically and presently have a higher rate of drop-outs and lesser chance of attending institutes of higher learning. It is important for school-aged children to have adequate and appropriate clothing in order to attend school and succeed while at school. All school-aged (Pre-K through 12th Grade) Sac and Fox Nation tribal members may participate in this program.

GUIDELINES:

1. Student must be an enrolled member of the Sac and Fox Nation. Applicants must provide the student's full name, a copy of tribal membership card, return mailing address, and have a school official complete a portion of the application.

2. All students must be currently enrolled or homeschooled; this program is for students in grades Pre-K through 12 only.

3. Applicants may apply only one time per school year, and this program is operated on a first-come, first-serve basis.

4. Each qualified student may receive a gift card in the amount of \$150; program funding is limited and will serve as many students as funding permits.

5. Applicants must return the expended gift card along with receipts documenting the purchases made with the card. Applicants who fail to comply with this requirement will not be eligible for funding in the subsequent school year.

6. Applicants who abuse a grant award by making purchases of items for other purposes or for persons other than the awardee shall lose all consideration for future funding.

Parents and legal guardians (applicants) should note that failure to comply with grant requirements and/or abuse of an award for one child places future funding for all of their qualified children at risk.

School Supplies Grant Guidelines

WHO MAY APPLY
To enroll in Oklahoma's Promise, you must:

- Be an Oklahoma resident.
- Apply during your 8th, 9th or 10th-grade year (homeschool students must apply while age 13, 14 or 15).
- Be the child of parents who earn \$50,000 or less per year at the time of application.
- Read and understand the requirements of the program as listed on back.

THE BENEFITS
Once you've completed the program's high school requirements and meet the college requirements, Oklahoma's Promise can help pay your tuition at an Oklahoma public two-year college or four-year university. It will also cover a portion of tuition at an accredited private college or university or for Oklahoma public technology center courses that qualify for credit from a public two-year college. (The Oklahoma's Promise scholarship amount does not cover items such as other required fees, books, supplies, or room and board.)
