Open Enrollment Period for Medicare Health and Drug Plans Begins October 15, 2011

The annual enrollment period for Medicare Drug and Health Plans begins earlier this year on October 15 thru December 7.

People with Medicare will have seven weeks to review Medicare Advantage and Part D Prescription drug coverage benefits and plan options. This earlier enrollment period also ensures that Medicare has enough time to process plan choices so that

coverage begins without interruption on January 1, 2012.
